

Support Officers of Whatcom County MATT HERZOG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Support Officers of Whatcom County (SOWC) are sponsoring a memorial scholarship in the memory of Deputy Matt Herzog. Deputy Herzog was a five-year veteran of the Whatcom County Sheriff's Office who made the ultimate sacrifice, while in the line of duty, in 2001. To honor Deputy Herzog's service and devotion to law enforcement, SOWC is proud to offer the Matt Herzog Memorial Scholarship for high school graduating seniors, or current college students, wishing to pursue a career in law enforcement or criminal justice.

The Award

This is a one-time, non-renewable, \$2000 scholarship available for fall of 2024. The applicant must be attending, or enrolling in, an accredited Washington State College or University on a part time or full-time basis for the 2024-2025 academic year. The applicant must be pursuing a career in, or related to, law enforcement.

Application Process:

The candidate shall submit the following with the application:

- Two letters of recommendation (See application form for source information)
- A 500-word (min) essay on "How I can make a difference in Law Enforcement."
- High school transcript, or if already in college, both high school and college transcripts.
- Oral interviews may be required depending upon the number of applicants.

Application and Award Dates

Acceptance of applications will be open April 1, 2024, and close on May 24, 2024. The SOWC Scholarship Committee will name the scholarship recipient in June of each year. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The scholarship will be issued to the recipient's selected college/university for use in tuition and/or related college fees upon proof of enrollment from institution's registrar's office.
